**The program**

The Western Michigan Chapter of AFS awards stipends to students who will be pursuing degrees in the Science, Technology, Engineering and Mathematics Fields (S.T.E.M.). Amounts are determined annually but typically range from \$250 - \$500 per student per year.

**Eligibility**

Student must have a minimum of 12 credits for full-time and 6 credits for part-time and carry a minimum 2.0 GPA. Student must be pursuing a degree in the S.T.E.M. programs. High School Seniors are also eligible for the stipends as long as they have maintained a minimum 2.0 GPA.

It is the recommendation of the Stipend Board that a current W.M. AFS member promote and sponsor the applicant.

**How to Apply**

Simply complete the application and return it via mail or e-mail to Eric Gildner using the contact information below by February 15. Applicant must include a copy of current transcript and current semester schedule to verify credit hours. The stipend committee will evaluate all applicants. Stipends will be paid directly to the individual at annual Student Night held at Muskegon Community College Monday March 14<sup>th</sup>, 2017. Recipients will receive invite.
