These stipends are awarded on a competitive basis, based on available funds. Meeting the basic eligibility requirements does not guarantee an award.

Eligibility

Students can be studying any discipline as long as they maintain a GPA of 3.0. Parents of the students must attend at least four West Michigan AFS meetings throughout the program year. The student must also submit an essay with this application including community involvement and their future plans.

Applicant must include a copy of current transcript and current semester schedule to verify credit hours. The stipend committee will evaluate all applicants.
