The program

The W.M. Chapter of AFS awards stipends to interested and qualified individuals who reside in the West Michigan area and are pursuing a degree program in materials-related fields of study at Muskegon Community College or other accredited college. The amount awarded varies (typically between \$250 and \$750 per student, per year).

Determination of Awards

Recipients are selected on a competitive basis with highest priority given to Materials Technology. Other factors which shall be considered are school and community participation, work experience, personal recommendations, applicant's educational goals and any unusual personal or family circumstances.

Eligibility

Student must have a minimum of 12 credits for full-time and 6 credits for part-time, carry a minimum 2.0 GPA and have taken a Materials class in the past, be currently enrolled in a Materials class OR show absolute intent of enrolling in a Materials class next semester. Student must also commit to attend "Student Night" held March 10th 2020 at MCC where recipient will be recognized.

How to Apply

Simply complete the application and return it via mail or e-mail to Travis Hepfner using the contact information below by February 28th 2022. Applicant must include a copy of current transcript and current semester schedule to verify credit hours. The stipend committee will evaluate all applicants. Stipends will be awarded and recipients notified by March 31st 2022
